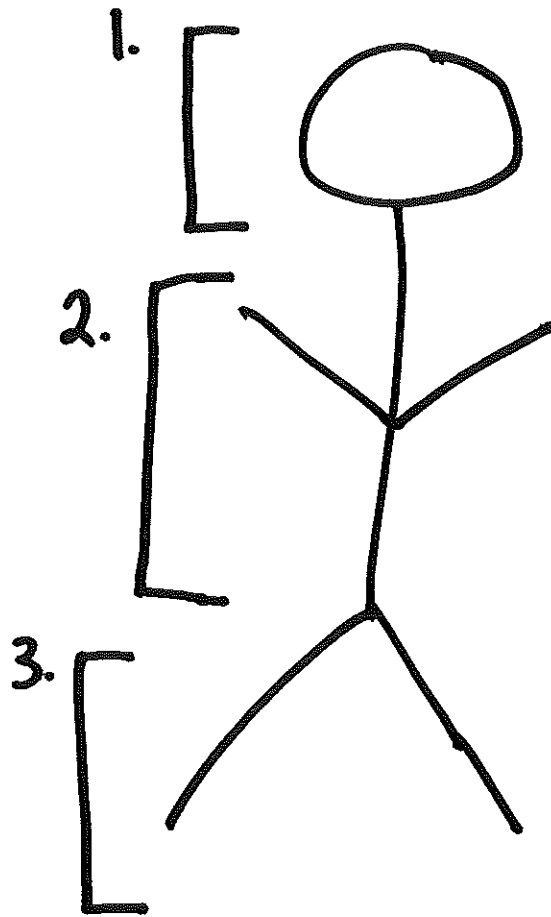

The Essay Man (page #1)

Think of an essay like the structure of this stick figure:



① Introduction -
Thesis Statement
{ main idea }

② Body
Paragraphs
these give
needed support
to your thesis

③ Conclusion -
gives your
essay "something
to stand on" -
wraps up your
ideas.

If you include these three parts your essay should be acceptable, but in order to write an essay that stands out and is creative, following this structure is **not** enough. You need to bring your own personality to your writing. Page #2 shows ways in which you can "add color" to your work.

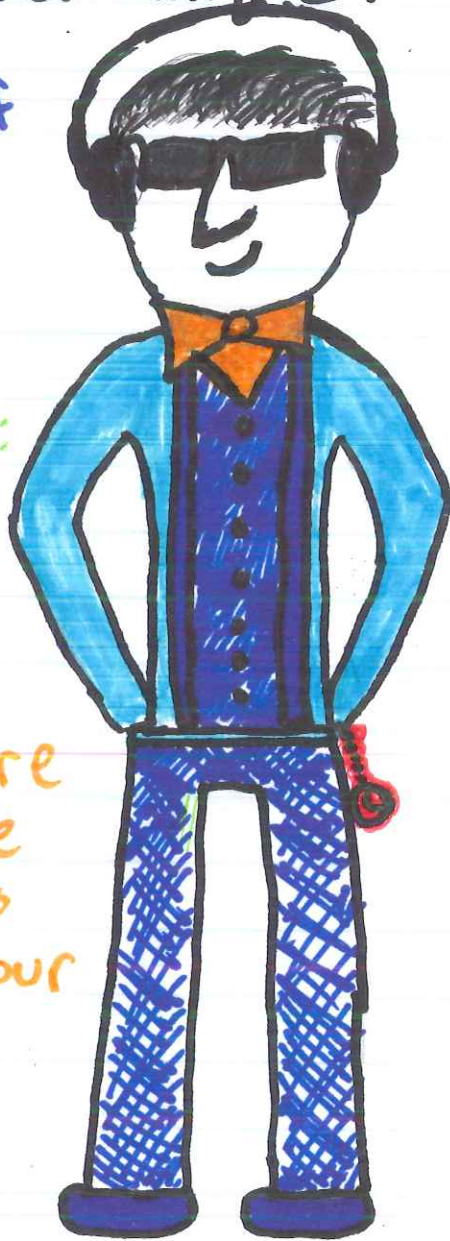
"The Essay Man" (Page # 2)
